Essential medicines list: Govt adds 34 new drugs, drops 26; all you need to know

Union health ministry on Tuesday added 34 new drugs and dropped 26 from the new revised list released by National List of Essential Medicines (NLEM), said Union Health Minister Mansukh Mandaviya.

A total of 384 drugs have been included in the National Lists of Essential Medicines (NLEM) 2022. The list has got the addition of 34 new drugs, while 26 from the previous list have been dropped. The medicines have been categorized into 27 therapeutic categories, said Mandaviya.



Several anti-cancer drugs, antibiotics and vaccines will now become more affordable as they are among 34 new additions to the National List of Essential Medicines, with the government saying this will reduce "patients' out-of-pocket expenditure".

देश में 7 करोड़ लोग इस बीमारी से परेशान, अब सरकार देगी केवल 60 रुपये में दवा



प्रधानमंत्री भारतीय जनऔषधि परियोजना के तहत देश भर में 8,700 से अधिक प्रधानमंत्री भारतीय जनऔषधि केन्द्र खोले गए है, जनऔषधि केंद्र पर फिलहाल 1,600 दवाएं और 250 सर्जिकल उपकरण उपलब्ध है, इंडियन काउंसिल ऑफ मेडिकल रिसर्च—इंडिया (ICMR) के अनुसार, देशभर में कुल 7,40 करोड़ लोगों को डायबिटीज है।
