Prices of the Jan Aushadhi medicines are generally 50% to 90% less costly than branded medicines and have same quality as that of expensive branded medicines. The product basket of PMBJP is very well equipped and now has been expanded to 1800 medicines and 285 surgical devices, in all 2085 products covering all major therapeutic groups. In all, during the past 9 years, total savings have been estimated at approximately more than Rs. 20,000 crores for the citizens under this noble scheme.

## Centre decides to allow 2,000 PACS to open Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras across India by December

New Delhi [India], June 6 (ANI): The Central government on Tuesday decided to allow 2,000 Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS) to open Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras across the country by December in a move to increase the income of PACS and create employment opportunities as well as medicines available at affordable prices to people.

As per the decision taken in the meeting, 2,000 PACS across the country will be identified to open Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras, said a Ministry of Cooperation statement, adding "a total of 1,000 Jan Aushadhi Kendras will be opened by August and 1,000 by December this year."

## North Eastern Railway plans PM Jan Aushadhi, aadhaar card outlets at 50 Railway stations

The North Eastern Railway (NER) has launched a mission to establish outlets of PM Jan Aushadhi at as many as 50 stations to provide convenience to passengers.

NER will soon float tenders for it and any graduate in pharmacy will be eligible to apply for the allocation of outlets as the railway has planned to set up these outlets at 50 stations (FOR REPRESENTATION)

Chief public relations officer Pankaj Kumar Singh confirmed that in the initial stage, these outlets will be set up at Lucknow, Varanasi, Gorakhpur and Kashipur Railway station where all necessary drugs will be available at a cheaper price. The model of the outlet has been designed by a Gujarat-based firm, he added.

Singh said that 120 sq ft space at a suitable place on an important platform will be provided for the outlet.

## 37 crore sanitary pads costing Rs.1 each sold under PMBJP scheme: Minister



Under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP), the central government has sold more than 37 crore sanitary pads for just Rs 1 per pad so far, Union Minister of State for Chemical and Fertilisers Bhagwanth Khuba said on Friday, May 26, at an event in Delhi.

"Last year, PMBJP had an annual sale of Rs 1,234 crore, in which generic medicine is available for below-the-poverty-line people at cheaper prices and it saved around Rs 7,500 crore compared with market price. Similarly, for sanitary pads selling at just Rs 1, we have recorded the sales of 37 crore (pads), so far," he said at the event organised by FICCI.

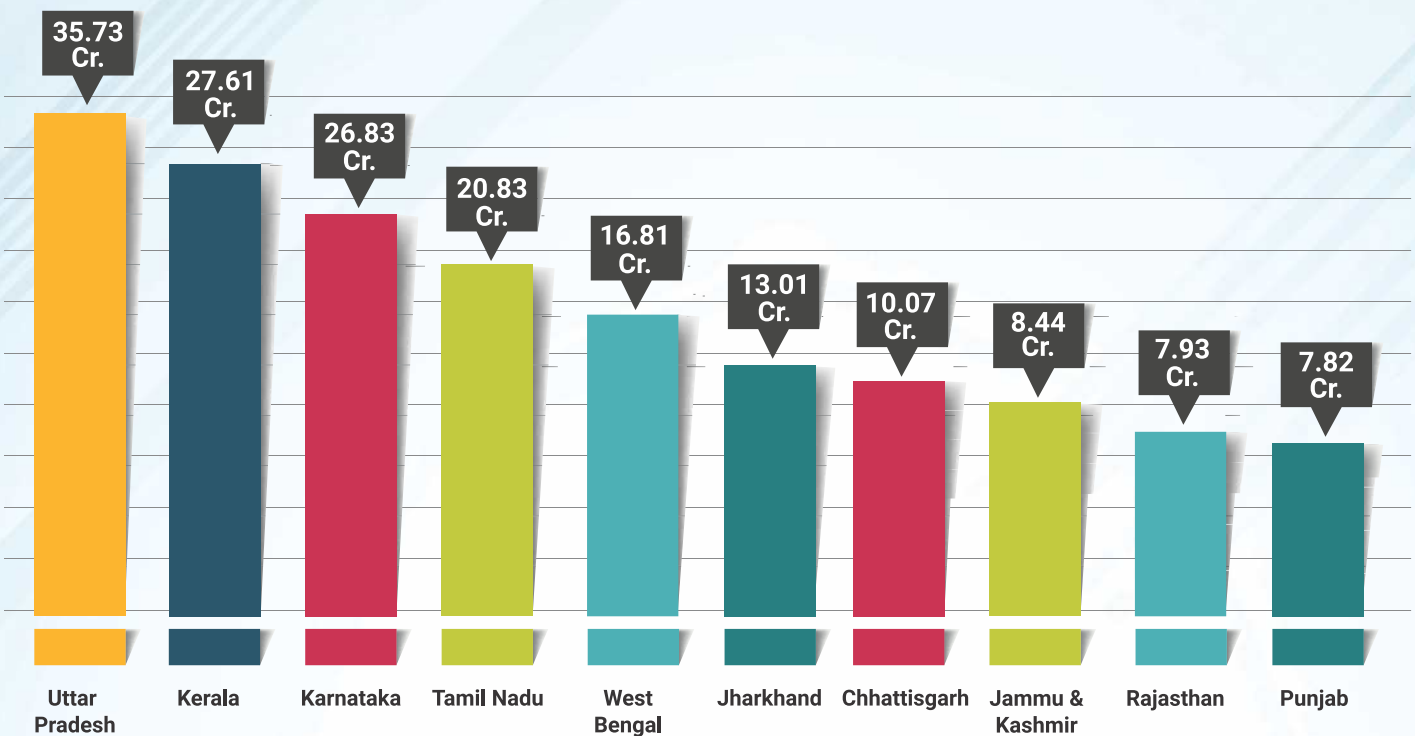
## Amethi News: अब अमेठी सीएचसी में मिलेगी सस्ती दवा
