Jan Aushadhi expands its generic footprint



At least 10,000 Jan Aushadhi Kendras are expected to be operational in the country by December.

Having started in 2008 as a modest initiative to supply less expensive, generic drugs to consumers, the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Jan Aushadhi Kendras now number 9,750plus countrywide and offer a larger basket of medicines and surgical products. Owners of these outlets in different parts of the country told businessline that they were seeing an increase in customers. However, they added, they still had to fight the perception that less expensive generic drugs are of low quality, besides tackling supply-chain challenges.

एटा। सहकारी समितियों को आर्थिक रूप से आत्मिनर्भर बनाने के साथ ही ग्रामीण इलाकों में सस्ती दवा उपलब्ध कराने की अनूठी पहल की जा रही है। सहकारी समितियों को पांच प्रधानमंत्री जनऔषधि केंद्र संचालित करने का लाइसेंस दिया जा रहा है। इसके लिए समितियों का चयन कर लिया गया है। वहीं औषधि केंद्र खोलने की प्रक्रिया भी शुरू कर दी गई है। नए केंद्र खुलने से इन पांचों स्थानों पर करीब 60 हजार की आबादी को सस्ती दवाओं का लाभ मिलेगा।


