### Panipat News: जन औषधि केंद्र के लिए दवा खरीदेगा स्वास्थ्य विभाग

**पानीपत।** स्वास्थ्य विभाग अब जिला नागरिक अस्पताल में जन औषधि केंद्र खोलने जा रहा है। इसके लिए स्वास्थ्य विभाग दवा खरीदेगा। फार्मासिस्ट दवाओं का ऑर्डर तैयार कर रहे हैं। केंद्र का प्रभारी नौल्था सामदायिक स्वास्थ्य केंद्र के फार्मासिस्ट राकेश कमार को बनाया गया है। पहले लगभग दो लाख रुपये की दवा खरीदी जाएगी।

नागरिक अस्पताल के प्रथम तल पर केंद्र खुलेगा। रोगियों को यहां कम दाम पर दवाइयां मिलेगी। मरीजों को बाहर से दवाएं नहीं खरीदनी पडेगी। फिलहाल रोगियों को जो दवा अस्पताल में उपलब्ध नहीं है वह दवा बाहर से महंगे दामों पर खरीदनी पड़ती है। जन औषधि केंद्र में दवाओं के दाम बाहर की अपेक्षा ७० प्रतिशत तक कम होंगे। बाहर मेडिकल स्टोर प र शगर की अमरियल एम-वन की 15 टेबलेट निजी मेडिकल पर 136 रुपये की मिलती हैं, लेकिन औषधि केंद्र पर यह सिर्फ 10 रुपये में दी जाएगी।

#### Perceived Utility of Jan Aushadhi Outlets and Awareness of Generic Medicines at the Andaman and Nicobar Islands: A Cross-Sectional Study

Despite being the leading exporter of generic medicines to the world, affordable medicines are still beyond the reach of most patients in India. Analysis of the National Sample Survey data showed that in one year, more than 55 million Indians became poor only because they had to spend their own money to purchase medicines. The Jan Aushadhi Scheme launched by the Government of India is an ambitious step to make quality generic drugs affordable to the common man of the country.

This study aimed to assess the knowledge, attitude, and perceptions of patients at a tertiary care teaching hospital in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands about Jan Aushadhi Kendras and generic

The study was a questionnaire-based cross-sectional study. A prevalidated self-made questionnaire was distributed to 200 patients visiting the OPD of different clinical departments in the hospital. Participants' knowledge, attitude, and perception of Jan Aushadhi Kendras and generic medicines were evaluated. Analysis of collected data was done using descriptive statistical measures such as mean and percentages.

Results: It was found that most of the participants were not fully aware of the Jan Aushadhi Scheme and the facts about generic medicines. The majority of the participants were under the notion that generics were not similar in quality to the branded





# **Asthma**



Asthma is a chronic lung disease affecting people of all ages. It is caused by inflammation and muscle tightening around the airways, which makes it harder to breathe.

Symptoms can include coughing, wheezing, shortness of breath and chest tightness. These symptoms can be mild or severe and can come and go over time.

## **Impact**

People with under-treated asthma can suffer sleep disturbance, tiredness during the day, and poor concentration. If symptoms are severe, people with asthma may need to receive emergency health care and they may be admitted to hospital for treatment and monitoring. In the most severe cases, asthma can lead to death.



#### **Causes**

- Asthma is more likely if other family members also have asthma particularly a close relative, such as a parent or sibling.
- Asthma is more likely in people who have other allergic conditions, such as eczema and rhinitis (hay fever).
- Urbanization is associated with increased asthma prevalence, probably due to multiple lifestyle factors.
- Events in early life affect the developing lungs and can increase the risk of asthma. These include low birth weight, prematurity, exposure to tobacco smoke and other sources of air pollution, as well as viral respiratory infections.
- Exposure to a range of environmental allergens and irritants are also thought to increase the risk of asthma, including indoor and outdoor air pollution, house dust mites, moulds, and occupational exposure to chemicals, fumes or dust.
- Of Children and adults who are overweight or obese are at a greater risk of asthma.

### **Treatment**

Asthma cannot be cured but there are several treatments available. The most common treatment is to use an inhaler, which delivers medication directly to the lungs.

Inhalers can help control the disease and enable people with asthma to enjoy a normal, active life.
