The main objective of this Kendra will be to provide affordable and quality medicines to the patients visiting AIIMS for the treatment of various ailments.

The new Kendra, spanning an area of 1,724 square feet, aims to provide over 2,047 quality generic medicines and 300 surgical devices at prices significantly lower than their branded counterparts, the press release stated.

Milestone Achieved In Jan Aushadhi Kendras Sales – ₹200 Crores in September 2024

Under the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP), as of September 30, 2024, a total of 13,822 Jan Aushadhi Kendras have been established across the country. Notably, in September 2024, these Kendras achieved record sales of ₹200 Crores, marking the highest monthly sales in the history of the PMBJP.

For comparison, in September 2023, sales were ₹141 Crores, highlighting a significant 42% year-on-year growth. This remarkable increase reflects the program's success in providing affordable and accessible healthcare solutions to the masses. Up to September 2024, there has been a 31.20% total annual growth, with the sales

target of ₹913.30 Crores already achieved. Almost 10 lakh people purchase medicines daily from Jan Aushadhi Kendras. In the last 10 years under PMBJP, the sale of medicines worth ₹6100 Crores through Kendras has led to estimated savings of ₹30,000 Crores for citizens compared to branded medicines.

'11 Crore Sanitary Pads Sold in 6.5 Months': Jan Aushadhi Now Biggest Pharmacy Chain in India, Says CEO



Sanitary pads, blood pressure pill telmisartan, antidiabetes pill metformin and acid reflux medicine pantoprazole are the top-selling medicines at the government's affordable medicine stores under Pradhan Mantri Bhartiva Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP), the top government official told News18.

The scheme sold 1.12 crore packets of sanitary pads of its own brand Suvidha in the last 6.5 months of the ongoing fiscal year. These are sold in packs of ten units, hence it sold 11.27 crore pads, so far – averaging at 1.73 crore sanitary pads every month. To provide affordable options to women in remote and rural areas, the scheme provides the packet of 10 pads at Rs 10, much lesser than the other branded options.

Health: पिछले 10 साल में जन औषधि केंद्र की संख्या में हुआ १७० गुणा का इजाफा



Health: आम लोगों को सस्ती और गुणवत्तापूर्ण दवा मुहैया कराने के लिए केंद्र सरकार ने प्रधानमंत्री भारतीय जन औषधि केंद्र खोला है. इस केंद्र पर कई तरह की दवा सस्ती कीमत पर उपलब्ध होती है. इस केंद्र ने एक नयी उपलब्धि दर्ज की है। इस साल अक्टूबर तक एक हजार करोड रुपये का कारोबार किया है। पिछले साल यह आंकड़ा दिसंबर में हासिल हो पाया था. मौजूदा समय में देश में 14 हजार जन औषधि केंद्र हैं. मंत्रालय का मानना है कि आम लोगों के बढ़ते भरोसे और गुणवत्ता पूर्ण दवा की उपलब्धता के कारण कारोबार लगातार बढ रहा है।

इस केंद्र पर सस्ती और गुणवत्ता पूर्ण दवा की उपलब्धता के कारण लोगों का स्वास्थ्य सेवा पर होने वाला खर्च कम हो रहा है। इस साल सितंबर महीने में ही जन औषधि केंद्र पर 200 करोड़ रुपये के दवा की बिक्री का रिकॉर्ड दर्ज किया गया। पिछले १० साल में जन औषधि केंद्र की संख्या में 170 गुणा की वृद्धि दर्ज की गयी है. वर्ष 2014 में ऐसे केंद्र की संख्या सिर्फ 80 थी, जो अब बढ़कर 14 हजार हो गयी है।

Demand for Jan Aushadhi Kendras increases as people get good quality medicines at cheaper rates






and more people avail of the cheap generic drugs available at the centres which are as effective as the expensive, branded drugs in the market.





Lymphoma Causes

Lymphoma starts with DNA changes in lymphocytes, disrupting normal cell growth and death. These alterations cause the lymphocytes to grow uncontrollably and live longer, leading to an excess of abnormal cells in the lymph nodes, spleen, and liver, which then enlarge.

Lymphoma Risk Factors

AGE:

60+ for non-Hodgkin lymphoma; 15-40 or 55+ for Hodgkin lymphoma.

VIRAL INFECTIONS:

Exposure to viruses like Epstein-Barr, hepatitis C, or HTLV-1.

GENDER:

Male or assigned male at birth (some subtypes are more common in females).

FAMILY HISTORY:

Close relative with lymphoma.

WEAK IMMUNE SYSTEM:

Due to HIV/AIDS, organ transplant, or congenital immune disease.

CHEMICAL EXPOSURE:

Contact with benzene or pesticides.


AUTOIMMUNE DISEASES:

Conditions like rheumatoid arthritis, Sjögren's syndrome, lupus, or celiac disease.

PREVIOUS LYMPHOMA TREATMENT:

History of Hodgkin or non-Hodgkin lymphoma.

Lymphoma Symptoms:



These symptoms can also indicate other illnesses. Consult a doctor for an accurate diagnosis.

Early warning sign: Painless swelling of lymph nodes in neck, groin, or underarm.

Lymphoma Diagnosis

To diagnose lymphoma, doctors begin with a physical exam to check for swollen lymph nodes and review family history and symptoms. If needed, a lymph node biopsy is done to detect cancer cells. Additional tests, like a bone marrow biopsy, chest X-ray, MRI, PET scan, and molecular tests, help diagnose, stage, and identify lymphoma type by examining tissues, imaging the chest, or detecting specific genetic changes in cancer cells.
