New Delhi (India), December 31 (ANI): The Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers on Saturday said that medicines are being made available under Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP), priced 50-90 percent less than that of branded medicines fulfilling Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of ensuring high-quality medicines at affordable prices to all.

Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) was launched by the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers, Government of India in November 2008.

Government Plans To Increase Number of Janaushadhi Kendras To 10,000 By March 2024



The government on Saturday said it plans to increase the number of generic drugs stores, the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) to 10,000 by March 2024 in order to accelerate the drive to make quality medicines available at affordable prices to all.

Around Rs 18,000 crore has been saved through the Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP) in last eight years and the government has deepened the reach of the scheme with more than 9,000 stores covering 743 out of 766 districts across the country, an official statement said.

Union Health Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya today, December 31, said that the number of Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendras has crossed 9,000 (Nine thousand) in the country.

In a tweet, the Minister said, these centers were started with the goal of providing cheap and good medicine to the people. He added that today, these centers are proving benefits to lakhs of people in every district of the country.

Jan Aushadhi Scheme' was launched by the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers, in November 2008. To give further impetus to the scheme, it was again renamed as 'Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana' (PMBJP) in 2016.

This scheme was launched with an objective of making quality generic medicines available at affordable prices to all. Chemicals and Fertilizers Ministry said that more than nine thousand Kendras have been opened till date covering 743 districts across the country.

Kathua News: लोगों को मिलेंगी सस्ती दर की जेनरिक दवाएं



कठुआ। आम लोगों को सस्ती दर पर जेनरिक दवाएं उपलब्ध कराने के लिए शहर के कॉलेज रोड पर जिले के नौंवें प्रधानमंत्री जन औषधि केंद्र का शुभारंभ हो गया है। बुधवार को इसका उद्घाटन स्टेट ड्रग कंट्रोलर लोतिका खजूरिया ने संयुक्त नियंत्रक ड्रग्स इरफाना, रिफत नजीर नोडल अधिकारी के साथ किया।

इस मौके पर औषधि एवं खाद्य नियंत्रण संगठन के पदाधिकारियों ने प्रधानमंत्री के फ्लैगशिप परियोजना के तहत खोले जाने वाले जन औषधि स्टोर में मिलने वाली सुविधा की जानकारी देते हुए कहा कि यहां बाजार में उपलब्ध दवाओं की तुलना में दवा की दरें 60 से 85 प्रतिशत तक कम हैं। जबिक दवाओं की प्रभावशीलता बाजार में उपलब्ध सभी ब्रांडों की दवाओं के बराबर है। लिहाजा लोगों को इसका लाभ उठाना चाहिए। वहीं, ड्रग कंट्रोलर ने कहा कि विभाग द्वारा नशीले पदार्थों की बिक्री के खिलाफ जीरो टॉलरेंस की नीति अपनाई जा रही है। समारोह में उपस्थित सभी केमिस्टों को नवीनतम कार्यप्रणाली और डग एंड कॉस्मेटिक एक्ट का पालन करने की सलाह से अवगत कराया गया।

Gurgaon शहर में 17 केंद्रों पर मरीजों को सस्ती दवाइयां मिलेंगी यहां खोले जाएंगे नए केंद्र

हरियाणा न्यूज़ डेस्क, मरीजों को सस्ती दवाइयां लेने के लिए अब भटकना नहीं पड़ेगा. जल्द नागरिक अस्पताल सहित उपमंडल नागरिक अस्पताल में भी बाजार से सस्ती दरों पर दवाइयां उपलब्ध होंगी. इसके लिए ११ नए प्रधानमंत्री जन औषधि केंद्र खोले जाएंगे. इसके लिए जगह चिन्हित कर लिए गए हैं. वर्तमान में जिले में छह जन औषधि केंद्र चल रहे हैं.

लोगों को बेहतर स्वास्थ्य सुविधाएं देने के उद्देश्य से इन केंद्रों की संख्या बढाने के लिए जिला उपायुक्त निशांत कुमार यादव की अध्यक्षता में बैठक हुई. इसमें सिविल सर्जन डॉ. वीरेंद्र यादव ने बताया कि प्रधानमंत्री जन औषधि केंद्रों को खोले जाने का उद्देश्य लोगों को कम मूल्य पर दवाइयां उपलब्ध करवाना है. यहां पर लोग बाजार में मिलने वाली दवाइयों से बहुत ही कम कीमत पर जेनेरिक दवाइयां प्राप्त कर सकते हैं. ये दवाइयां ब्रांडेड दवाइयों जितनी ही प्रभावी होती हैं. जिससे आमजन विशेषकर आर्थिक रूप से कमजोर नागरिकों को बड़े पैमाने पर लाभ मिलेगा. उन्होंने बताया कि वर्तमान में छह जन औषधि केंद्र चल रहे हैं. सेक्टर-४/७ चौक, कृष्णा कांप्लेक्स सेक्टर-५२, सेक्टर- ४ स्थित जैन संत फूलचंद चैरिटेबल अस्पताल, शॉप नंबर-२ प्लॉट नंबर -147 विश्वकर्मा कॉलोनी, मारुति कुंज गेट भोंडसी में इनका संचालन हो रहा है.



Challenges of Hypertension and Cardiovascular disease in recent time

According to the estimation of WHO (World Health Organization), about 12% people with hypertension in India have their blood pressure under control. This shares a glaring picture of the status of hypertension among Indians in recent time. Uncontrolled blood pressure for a long time is one of the main risk factors for developing cardiovascular diseases (CVDs) such as heart attacks and stroke, and are responsible for 1/3 of total deaths in India. According to WHO, nearly 63% of the deaths in India are due to noncommunicable diseases, of which 27% are due to Cardiovascular issues. Blood pressure is referred as the pressure of blood against the walls of the arteries. It is generally understood in terms of Systolic and diastolic blood pressure. The normal range of blood pressure is less than 120/80 mmHg. The age brackets to be affected by high blood pressure are largely between 45-69. Prolonged diseases are developed as a result of uncontrolled blood pressure.

Hypertension develops overtime and it is closely related to lifestyle choices of individuals. The impact of High blood pressure overtime can severely damage heart, brain, kidneys and other major organs of the body. When the flow of blood is obstructed leading to less oxygen supply to the heart, people experience heart diseases. Zone wise division of hypertension issues are elaborated through this following chart.



Blood pressure over a long time is also known as a "silent killer" as it does not provide any major symptoms and most of the people are not even aware of their presence.

Several reasons for higher blood pressures are overweight, adding excessive salt in food consumption, lesser intake of fruits and vegetables, not having enough exercise as part of the daily routine, smoking, disturbances in sleep and ageing to name a few. In achieving the target of 25% relative reduction of hypertension among Indians, The Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Pariyojana has come up with high quality medicines with 50-90% cheaper costs for the people suffering with high Blood pressure issues.

Role of PMBJP in eradicating hypertension

High blood pressure among the young and elderly is likely to take 1.47 million lives per year in India; it is one of the major health concerns of the elderly population especially above the age of 60. PMBJP has been successful in reaching out to the middle class and poor masses in India by reducing the risk of high blood pressure related diseases as it ensures affordable quality medicines at 50-90% cheaper rates. The elderly population who are retired and pension dependent are largely benefitted from the PMBJP medicines easily accessible through the Pradhan Mantri Jan Aushadhi Kendras.

PMBJP has enabled accessibility to medicines of controlling high blood pressure through their wide range of medicine basket, targeted towards specific diseases. Under PMBJP scheme, one strip of Amlodipine would cost Rs. 5/- in comparison to a marketed brand of Rs.28/- (No medicine in this category can be purchased without medical prescription)

PMBJP consists of more than 12 different medications for the targeted treatment of high blood pressure. PMBJP has drastically reduced the out of the pocket budget of the Indian consumers and lower the burden of expensive medicines for cure of high blood pressure.

Government has deepened the reach of PMBJP with more than 9000 stores covering 744 out of 766 districts across the country. The Government has set a target to increase the number of Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) to 10,000 by March 2024. The product basket of PMBJP comprises 1759 medicines and 280

surgical devices covering all major therapeutic groups such as Cardiovascular, Anti-cancers, Anti-diabetics, Anti-infectives, Anti-allergic, Gastro-intestinal medicines, Nutraceuticals, etc. In the financial year 2021-22, sale of Rs. 893.56 Crore has been done, which has led to savings of about Rs. 5300 Crore to the citizens as compared to the branded medicines. In the current financial year i.e., 2022-23, till 31.12.2022, PMBI has made sales of Rs. 869.12 Crore which led to savings of approximately Rs. 4500 Cr. to the citizens. Thus, in all, Rs. 18,000 Crore have been saved under this Pariyojana in last 8 years.
