## PM Janaushadhi stores make ₹1,000cr revenue

The scheme saved over ₹20,000 crore for the citizens, says govt

The revenue from the sale of generic medicines across India through Pradhan Mantri Bharatiya Janaushadhi Kendras (PMBJKs) has crossed ₹1,000 crore mark in the current financial year. The Union government believed that by the end of the financial year, the PMBJKs will register sales revenue of ₹1,200 crore which will be a sharp increase from ₹263 crore in 2016. The Government

said that the flagship scheme to provide medicines at low cost has saved more than ₹20,000 crore of citizens.

Chief Executive Officer (CEO), PMBI under the department of Pharmaceuticals, Ravi Dadhich told that sales revenue of ₹1,050 crore have been registered till mid February and it will be ₹1,200 crore by the end of financial year 2022-23.

सीनियर डीसीएम सुधीर सिंह ने बताया की जल्द ही रेलवे स्टेशन पर जन सुविधा स्टोर बनाया जाएगा। दैनिक उपयोग की वस्तुओं से लेकर दवाइयों और भोजन की व्यवस्था मिलेगी। मुरादाबाद स्टेशन पर फूड प्लाजा पहले से ही प्रस्तावित है। यह पार्सल हाल की तरह बनाया जा सकता है।

विभिन्न प्रकार के भोजन का आनंदरेलवे ने ड्राइंग भी लगभग तैयार कर ली है। यात्री इसमें फास्ट फूड साउथ इंडियन से लेकर विभिन्न प्रकार के भोजन का आनंद ले सकेंगे। इसके अलावा प्लेटफार्म नंबर एक पर बने नए ओवर ब्रिज के पास लिफ्ट में एक्सीलेटर लगाए जाएंगे। इससे बुजुर्गों और दिव्यांगों को काफी सहायता होगी। एक स्टेशन एक उत्पाद योजना के तहत लगाए पीतल की वस्तुओं के स्टॉल को भी बढ़ावा दिया जाएगा।

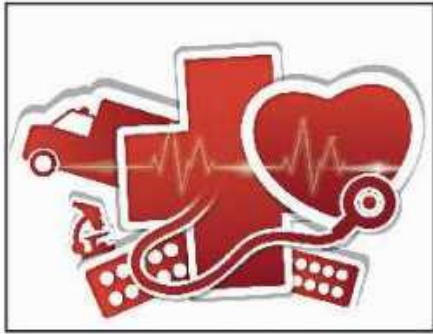

## ‘विदेश में भी लागू होगी जन औषधि योजना, 10 हजार सेंटर का लक्ष्य’



**नई दिल्ली:** देश के लोगों को सस्ती और गुणवत्तापूर्ण दवाएं उपलब्ध करवाने के मकसद के साथ शुरू की गई प्रधानमंत्री भारतीय जन औषधि परियोजना से विदेशी प्रतिनिधि भी प्रभावित हुए हैं। केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य मंत्री डॉ. मनसुख मांडविया और विदेश मंत्री डॉ. एस. जयशंकर की मौजूदगी में इस परियोजना के बारे में करीब 100 साझीदार देशों के विदेशी मिशन के प्रमुखों को प्रेजेंटेशन दिया गया। कई देश लोगों को सस्ती दवाएं मुहैया करवाने के इस मॉडल से प्रभावित हुए हैं और वे अपने देश में भी इस मॉडल को लागू करने के बारे में भारत का सहयोग लेंगे। केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य मंत्री डॉ. मांडविया ने कहा कि भारत को सही मायने में दुनिया की फार्मसी कहा जाता है। 50 प्रतिशत निर्यात और विश्व भर में हर पांच जेनेरिक गोलियों में से एक भारत में उत्पादित होती है। उन्होंने कहा कि वाजार की तुलना में जन औषधि केंद्रों पर 50 प्रतिशत से लेकर 80 प्रतिशत तक सस्ती और गुणवत्तापूर्ण दवाएं उपलब्ध करवाई जा रही हैं।

## जन औषधि केन्द्रों में अब तक बेचे गए 34.71 करोड़ से अधिक सेनेटरी पैड, 218.45 करोड़ रुपये की हुई बचत

**नई दिल्ली,** 20 फरवरी (हि.स.) देश के जन औषधि केन्द्रों के माध्यम से 34.71 करोड़ से अधिक जन औषधि सुविधा सेनेटरी पैड बेचे जा चुके हैं इससे कुल 218.45 करोड़ रुपये की बचत हुई है।

सोमवार को केंद्रीय स्वास्थ्य मंत्री डॉ. मनसुख मांडविया ने ट्विट करके कहा की महिलाओं के लिए स्वच्छता स्वास्थ्य और सुविधा सुनिश्चित करना सरकार की प्राथमिकता है। एक रुपये प्रति पैड की दर से 34.71 करोड़ से अधिक जन औषधि सुविधा सेनेटरी पैड बेचे गये। इससे कुल 218.45 करोड़ रुपये की बचत हुई है।

उल्लेखनीय है की विश्व पर्यावरण दिवस की पूर्व संध्या पर 4 जून, 2018 को केंद्र सरकार ने महिलाओं के लिए जन औषधि सुविधा ओक्सो-बायोडिग्रेडेबल सेनेटरी नैपकिन लांच की घोषणा की थी। तब से लेकर फरवरी 2023 तक जन औषधि केन्द्रों के माध्यम से 34.71 करोड़ से अधिक सेनेटरी नैपकिन बेचे जा चुके हैं।

## PMBJP : ब्रांडेड दवाओं के मुकाबले 50 से 90 फीसदी सस्ती मिलती है यह दवाएं, असर में कोई अंतर नहीं, लोगों के बचाए 4500 करोड़ रुपये

भारत सरकार के रसायन और उर्वरक मंत्रालय के अधीन औषध विभाग ने नवंबर, 2008 में प्रधानमंत्री भारतीय जनऔषधि परियोजना (PMBJP) को शुरू किया था। इसका उद्देश्य सभी को सस्ती कीमत पर गुणवत्तापूर्ण जेनेरिक दवाइयों (generic drugs) उपलब्ध कराना है। इस योजना के तहत दिसंबर, 2017 में 3,000 केंद्र खोलने का लक्ष्य प्राप्त किया गया। इसके अलावा मार्च, 2020 में कुल 6000 आउटलेट्स को खोलने का संशोधित लक्ष्य भी प्राप्त कर लिया गया था।

इस यात्रा में पिछले वित्तीय वर्ष में इन केंद्रों की संख्या 8,610 से बढ़कर अब 9,000 हो गई है। इसे देखते हुए सरकार ने पूरे देश के 766 जिलों में से 743 को कवर करते हुए 9,000 से अधिक केंद्रों के साथ इसकी पहुंच का विस्तार किया है। सरकार ने मार्च 2024 तक प्रधानमंत्री भारतीय जनऔषधि केंद्रों (Prime Minister of India Janaushadhi Kendras) की संख्या बढ़ाकर 10,000 करने का लक्ष्य रखा है।

पीएमबीजेपी के तहत उपलब्ध दवाओं की कीमत ब्रांडेड दवाओं की तुलना में 50 से 90 फीसदी तक कम है। वित्तीय वर्ष 2021-22 में 893.56 करोड़ रुपये की बिक्री हुई है। इससे नागरिकों को ब्रांडेड दवाओं की तुलना में लगभग 5,300 करोड़ रुपये की बचत हुई है। चालू वित्तीय वर्ष यानी 2022-23 में इन केंद्रों ने 30 नवंबर, 2022 तक 758.69 करोड़ रुपये की बिक्री की है। इससे नागरिकों को लगभग 4,500 करोड़ रुपये की बचत हुई। कुल मिलाकर इसकी बिक्री में अभूतपूर्व बढ़ोतरी देखी गई है, जो जन औषधि की व्यापक स्वीकृति को दिखाती है।

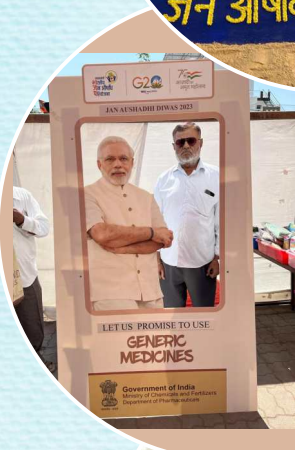
