**Note:** -1. Bids shall be submitted online only at CPPP website: <https://eprocure.gov.in>. Manual bids shall not be accepted except for the original documents/instruments as mentioned in tender document.

2. Bidders are advised to follow the 'Special Instructions to the Contractors/Bidders for the e-submission of the

bids online' available through the link 'Help for Contractors' at the-Procurement Portal <https://eprocure.gov.in>.

3. Bidder shall not modify the downloaded tender form including downloaded price bid template in any manner. In case any tender form/Price bid template is found to be tampered with/modified in any manner, such bid will be summarily rejected, Bid Security would be forfeited, and bidder is liable to be banned from doing business with PMBI.
4. Bidders are advised to check the *website of PMBI*: [janaushadhi.gov.in](http://janaushadhi.gov.in) and CPPP website <https://eprocure.gov.in> at least 3 days prior to closing date of submission of tender for any corrigendum, addendum, or amendment to the tender document.
5. The detailed terms and conditions have given in tender document. Likely bidders are requested to go through the tender and quote for Disposal of Expiry Drugs in accordance with requirements stated in the tender documents. Self-attested documents as required in tender document should be uploaded while submitting online bid. In absence of above document, the bid will be liable to be ignored and not considered.
6. Tender cost: The tender document can be downloaded free of cost from the CPPP e-Procurement Portal <https://eprocure.gov.in> and from the website of PMBI: [janaushadhi.gov.in](http://janaushadhi.gov.in).
7. Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)/ Bid Security Declaration: The bidder must submit a 'Bid Security Declaration' declaring disqualification/suspension of his bid in case the bid is withdrawn or modified by him during the bid validity period. The format of 'Bid Security Declaration' is available in the Tender Document. 'Bid Security Declaration' duly signed must be uploaded while submitting the e-bid. Tenders received without the 'Bid Security Declaration' will be rejected (except in the case of NSIC/MSEs registered bidders).

The Micro and Small enterprises (MSEs) and the firms registered with National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) etc. are exempted from submitting the Bid Security as per prevailing rules. However, they have to submit the valid documentary evidence in support of MSE/Registration with NSIC (indicating the items for which they are registered.) along with the technical bid.
